## #4 INNOVATIVE CAMPUS

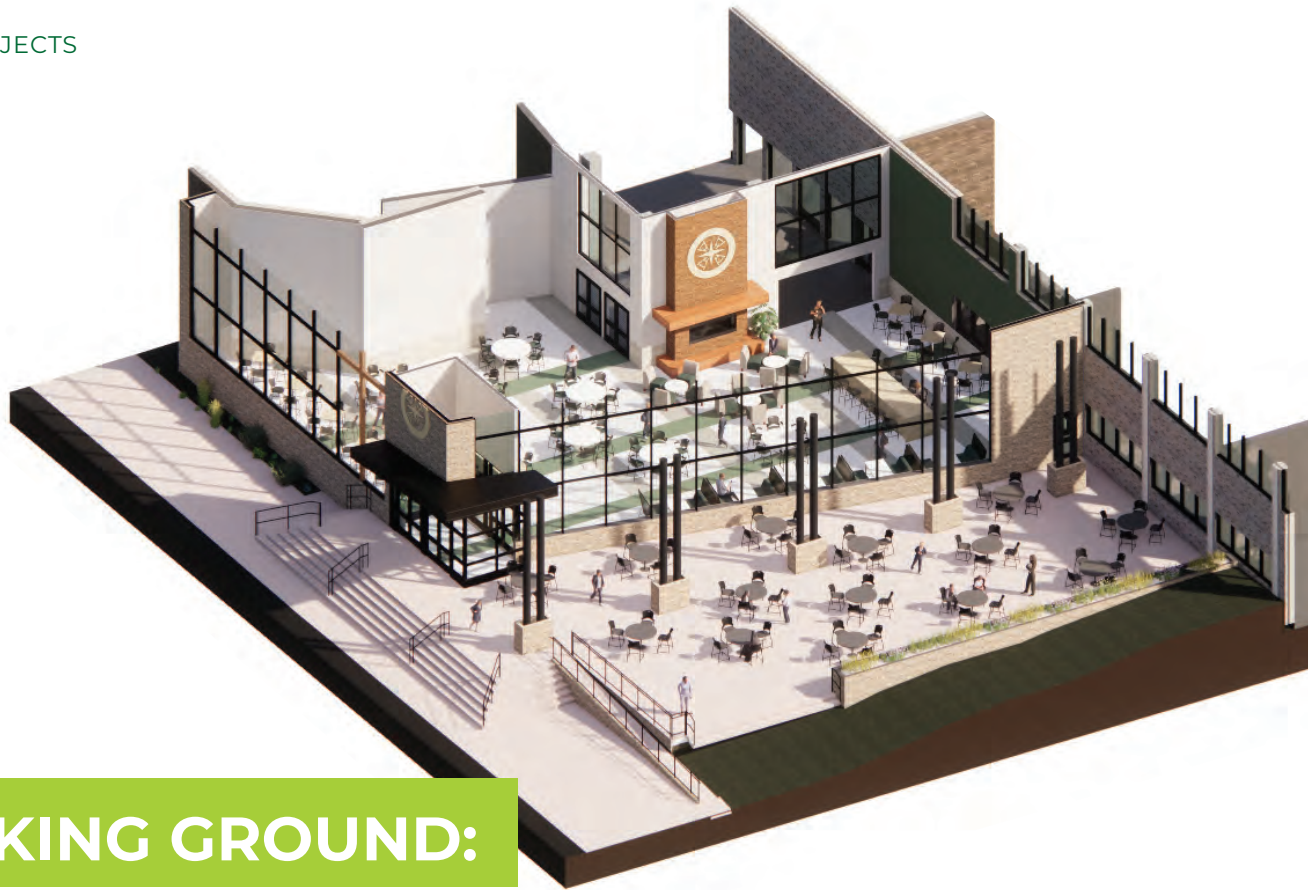
Our goal is for all who step onto our campus to feel a sense of welcome, a spirit of innovation, and a reverence for our commitment to faith, values, and sustainability.

## BREAKING GROUND: Hill-Murray Student Union

After an outstanding first year of the *Believe. Belong. Be Bold.* Comprehensive Campaign, we are thrilled to share that we've reached a significant milestone—it is time to break ground on the new Hill-Murray Student Union.

This capital project will add almost 7,500 square feet of versatile indoor and outdoor spaces, designed to enhance student life and learning. The new west-side entrance will lead into an expanded student union, while an adjacent patio will provide space for seasonal gatherings and open-air learning.

The Student Union addresses three key areas at Hill-Murray: functionality and growth, expanding opportunities, and strengthening community.

With enrollment continuing to exceed 1,000 students, Hill-Murray's dining areas have become increasingly crowded during lunch. The 4,000 square foot interior addition will offer much-needed space, ensuring students can comfortably enjoy their lunch while maintaining the current school day schedule.

Inspired by the collaborative spaces often found on college campuses, the Student Union will offer flexible areas for group projects, independent study, and innovative learning. Teachers will have the freedom to transform this space for non-traditional, creative learning experiences.

Beyond serving students and staff, the new Student Union will be a hub for alumni and the greater Hill-Murray community—offering a welcoming space to gather, reconnect, and strengthen bonds.

# GO BOLDLY, LIVE FULLY:

## Introducing the Pioneer Institute for Health and Wellness

Four years ago, members of the Hill-Murray community came together to establish the school's priorities with an ambitious goal: to make Hill-Murray one of the finest Catholic schools in the country. The result was *Go Boldly: The Hill-Murray Strategic Plan*.

As a part of the Transformational Learning pillar of the *Go Boldly* strategic plan, the dream of the Pioneer Institute for Health and Wellness (PIHW) was created. After much collaboration, study and discernment, Hill-Murray is poised to rise to the next level and bring the PIHW to life.



The Pioneer Institute for Health and Wellness will provide opportunities for support, exploration, and growth in the intellectual, emotional, social, spiritual, and physical wellness of students, staff, and the wider Hill-Murray community. A hallmark of Catholic education is attending to the whole person, ensuring that students are best supported in learning and growing. Through the work of the PIHW, we will strive to find balance in our community while working to reach our fullest potential.

It has been proven that students can only perform their best academically when their overall well-being is in order. Therefore, Hill-Murray has asked, "What challenges do our students face, and what can we do to support them?"

The post-graduate success of Hill-Murray students is a goal we are all striving toward. In order to provide Hill-Murray graduates with the tools for this success, they must first understand the connection between health and wellness with learning and achievement. The Pioneer Institute of Health and Wellness will use a variety of approaches to achieve this goal.

The Pioneer Institute of Health and Wellness work is already underway at Hill-Murray. Efforts to address challenges that students face—some of which are new and unique to this generation—will continue as the PIHW grows.

The new Cell Phone Policy, in partnership with Yondr, aims to reduce distractions and increase engagement in learning environments. Schools that have adopted the Yondr Education Program have reported notable improvements in academic performance, student behavior, and wellness metrics.

In addition, Hill-Murray launched a new daily schedule in the 2023-2024 school year designed to support mental health and reduce stress. This revised schedule, developed in collaboration with Independent School Management, maximizes time for deep learning, transformational experiences, and faculty collaboration and development.

Other examples of the Pioneer Institute for Health and Wellness in action include a community book study featuring *The Anxious Generation* by Jonathan Haidt, a review of the Health and Physical Education curriculums, and plans for an expanded Athletic Entrance and improvements that will include flexible space.

Katie Francis has been hired as the Director of the Pioneer Institute for Health and Wellness to drive and lead these initiatives. Katie brings a wealth of experience as a school counselor and driving health and wellness initiatives, most recently at Hudson High School and the Hudson School District. Katie says, "When I saw the job description for this position, the calling to apply was something I could not ignore. Now that I am here in this community, I know this is where I am meant to be."

Katie will lead the development of the PIHW, focusing on three core values: Community, Culture, and Curriculum.

The Pioneer Institute for Health and Wellness represents a bold step forward in Hill-Murray's commitment to nurturing the whole person. Rooted in Catholic traditions and aligned with the goals of the *Go Boldly* Strategic Plan, the PIHW embodies Hill-Murray's dedication to providing students with the tools for academic success and personal growth. Under the leadership of Katie Francis and with the active engagement of students, staff, and families, the PIHW is set to become a cornerstone of the Hill-Murray experience.

Through innovative programs, thoughtful policies, and a commitment to fostering balance in all aspects of life, Hill-Murray continues to evolve as a leader in education—preparing students not only for academic success but for a lifetime of well-being and leadership, grounded in the teachings of Christ. As the PIHW grows, so too will our community's ability to face the challenges of tomorrow with confidence, resilience, and grace.

## an interview with Maureen McDonough '74

Maureen McDonough, Class of 1974, recently attended her 50th Hill-Murray High School reunion. As a part of the *Believe. Belong. Be Bold. Comprehensive Campaign*, Maureen committed to a Legacy Gift benefiting Hill-Murray.

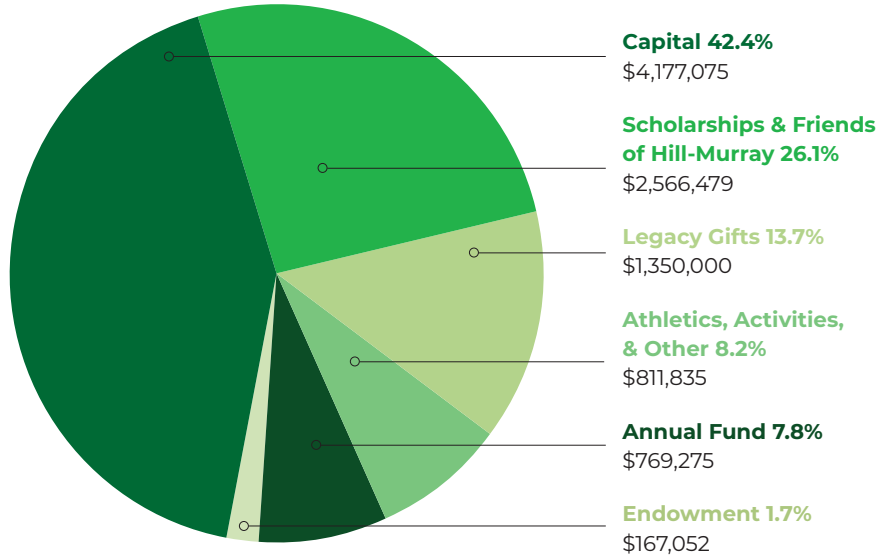

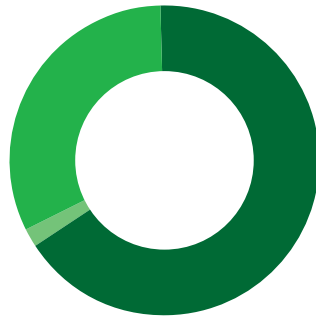

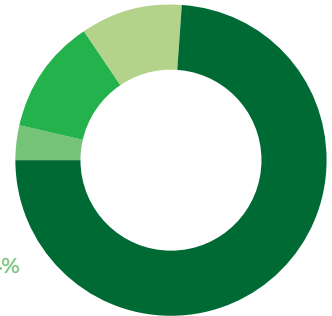
