

Summer Reading Program

The Nicholas Center at Hill-Murray School, in partnership with Youth Advantage of Stillwater, invites all struggling readers **entering grades 1st-6th in the fall of 2025** to join us for The *Nicholas Center Summer Reading Program* at Hill-Murray. The *Summer Reading Program* is a 6-week, structured literacy program that focuses on boosting literacy skills in students, including phonological and phonemic awareness, vocabulary development, morphology, comprehension, and fluency.

The Summer Reading Program students will have the opportunity to read daily, receive direct instruction based in the Science of Reading, interact with their peers during a myriad of literacy activities, take home books to keep and read courtesy of The Free Book Buggie and Literacy Minnesota, and take a journey down an individualized reading path through their interaction with a multisensory, structured reading iPad app.

Most importantly, students will discover a love for reading and a confidence that will permeate all other aspects of their lives!

The 6-week *Summer Reading Program* will run every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from June 17th, 2025 through July 31st, 2025 from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm. (Note: NO programming July 1, 2, 3)
